Outstanding Actions/Tasks

Item #17- Kelli was to send all HL coaches new Law of Game #4. She has not done so yet.

Item #18- Antonella was to go back and check cost of practice t-shirts. She found that Sew Kool was the cheapest to go with. Costco was only .28 cents lower but they were to add shipping and handling and set up fees. 1,000 t-shirts were ordered for \$5.12 each. A variety of sizes: youth med. 50/large 100/XL80 /Adult sizes s 150/m 250/l 250/XL 100/XXL 20. Sew Kool needed a cd with our silk screened logo and the club did not have one so Antonella told him to go ahead and copy the embroidered one. Cost of \$80.00.

Item #19- Kelli finalized the sponsor sheet and sent it to Antonella.

Item #20- Matt confirmed with the Municipal office the kick off date.

Item #21- Colin purchased a printer for the office.

U11-boys – Terry Kehoe, Cathy Vandenneem and Carol Bertrand were at the meeting with concerns with the two U11 boy's teams. Terry wanted to know the club's explanation to their decision in making two teams. Carol was concerned that the 2nd team was not getting enough out of learning process. Kelli made it clear that a decision was not made hastily. It took a lot of different comments from everyone before the entire club decided that it was best to have the two teams. She made it clear that Rob Cornel did not make any decisions. He gave his opinions/suggestions but it was up to the executives to make a final decision. It was suggested that Rob's team be made a premier one but he declined saying that they were not ready. There were enough players left once Rob picked his team to make a second one. The club thought it was better to make a second team instead of sending those players to House League. Next year the boys would be playing on a bigger field with more of them so it would be better that those others still be involved in the competitive league.

Jeff let us all know that he was against having the two teams in Div. 1. He would much rather have two separate teams. One in Premier and the other in Div. 1. Matt explained that when he started with the U10 years ago they never won a game. Now after many years those girls have made the Premier league. Antonella also commented that the U12 girls last year never won a game. But that didn't stop them from trying there hardest to win. They were determined to keep going and continue practicing. Terry says that boys and girls are very different when it comes to competitiveness.

Kelli said that if the parents were so against the second team why are they just speaking up right now. They should have come forward as soon as the second team was mentioned. Then they could have pulled their son from the team. If she knew so many were upset the club would have pulled the second team and just placed them all in House League.

Terry commented that Rob had told the parents at the last tryout that the two teams would be divided and not be on the same division. Kelli told Terry that that was partly her fault. She thought the League would do that but they opted not too and put both U11 on same division.

Chris also let the parents know that they were very fortunate to also have referees working at their games. This also is a good learning experience for the boys. They will learn more of the rules with referees.

Carol wanted to hear what Frank's opinion was towards it all. Frank said he disagreed with Terry that the boys would lose all games because there just weren't any strength there. Frank believes that they do have a lot of heart. He truly believes that that team will be in the middle category not at the end. He stated that we should all be looking for the development of all players not what parents feel their children should be. He said we should be asking ourselves what could we do to improve the team. How can we work with the team and help them become number one.

Frank is willing to work with the team with their skills etc.

Rob Fnukal said that there's still room for comments/suggestions to be made at the end of the season, for the club to look at how they could change the ways things could be done.

Carol suggested that the minutes be posted on the web site so that parents can know ahead of time what' going on with their child's teams.

KEMPTVILLE TOURNAMENT: Nancy had some questions and asked Antonella to relay them. 1st and Ottawa U11 Premier team wants into Kemptville's Tournament. They want to know if they can play in U12-D1 division. Or do they

wait to see if other U11 Premier teams register. The club said that they could play in U12 D1. 2nd she wanted to know who all had keys to mailbox. It concerns her that if there are too many with keys there is more chance of having things (registrations) misplaced. She would ideally like to get the Tournament registrations ASAP and confirm with that club. It was suggested that maybe next year we could have a mailbox for Tournaments. It is something that will be looked into for the next Tournament.

Kevin offered to help her with referee scheduling when the time comes if she would like.
