<p>Responsibility of Team Official</p> <p>The coach's name shall be entered on the game report and they shall identify themselves to the referee before the start of the game.</p> <p>No team official may enter the field of play unless requested by the referee.</p> <p>No team official has the right to withdraw their team from the field without the approval of the referee.</p> <p>The home team shall assign the two team "benches" to separate areas on the same side of the field. Spectators are restricted to the opposite side of the field from the teams.</p> <p>Team officials are fully responsible for the conduct of their players, officials and spectators at and in the vicinity of the games in which they are participate.</p>	<p>Duration of Games</p> <p>Games shall be of the following duration:</p> <p>U13 two 35 minute halves</p> <p>U15 two 40 minute halves</p> <p>U16+ two 45 minute halves</p> <p>Game Times</p> <p>Games will start at 6:30 pm May – July 31 and 6:00 p.m. Aug 1 – Sept.</p>
<p>Equipment</p> <p>All players on the same team (except the goalie) shall wear the same shirt colour. The goalies shall wear a shirt of a different colour from their teams as well as the oppositions.</p> <p>Where in the opinion of the referee, a similarity of colours could be confusing the home team shall change providing the visiting team colours are as listed with the league. If not, the visiting team shall change.</p> <p>All player shirts must be numbered, except for the goalie. Numbers must be at least 8 inches in height. No two players may wear the same number. They player's number shall be indicated on the game sheet beside their name. No player shall change their number during the game without the referee's permission.</p> <p>Each team shall provide and put in place, corner flags.</p> <p>The home team should provide nets. Both teams are to put these nets in place and remove them after the game.</p> <p>All game balls are size 5.</p>	<p>Number of Players & Substitutions</p> <p>A minimum of seven and a maximum of twenty-five players shall constitute a team in SSSL.</p> <p>Substitutions shall be allowed on the signal of the referee at halftime, goal kicks, after a goal or to replace an injured player.</p> <p>There shall be no limit in the number of substitutions made by a team in any game in SSSL. In addition, at levels up to and including U13, substitutions shall be allowed on corner kicks at the option of the attacking team. If the attacking team exercised the option to make a substitution (s), the defending team may also make a substitution(s)</p> <p>A team may change its goalkeeper for any player already on the field at any stoppage in play provided proper notice is given to the referee in accordance with FIFA Law 3.</p>
<p>Game Sheets</p> <p>SSSL Game Sheets (signed by the designated coach present at the game) with attached permits, etc, must be provided to the referee prior to the start of the game.</p> <p>These sheets MUST BE COMPLETELY FILLED OUT before being submitted to the referee.</p> <p>If a player is listed on the game sheet they are considered to have played in that game.</p> <p>Any player under suspension must have the word suspension printed besides his/her name on the game sheet or he/she is not considered to have sat out the game. Failure to identify players under suspension may result in disciplinary action by the SSSL.</p>
